### Principal's Message

#### **Sports in Schools**

Our school was lucky enough to receive a grant from Sporting Schools, which has allowed us to engage a third party "Sports in Schools' to run a gymnastics and fundamental movement skills program for the next 3 weeks. All students will engage in the program with no expense to the parents. I would like to thank Mr Wilkinson for completing the grant application.

#### **COVID** restrictions at school

As you may already be aware, restrictions eased across the state and in school on Monday 8 November. We are still operating in accordance with our ventilation report and will continue to maximise learning outside as much as possible. Our school continues to separate cohorts of students between breaks and adhere to social distancing where possible. Fully vaccinated parents and carers will be allowed on site to support curriculum delivery, vulnerable students or students with disability, student wellbeing activities and school operations (for example reading support, canteens and uniform shops), or to attend essential meetings (e.g. suspension meetings). Parents and carers must check in using the school check-in, show proof of vaccination on entry to the school site and follow mask-wearing requirements. Assemblies and presentations will be allowed outdoors on site. Cohorts should be separated with physical distancing in place where practicable. Care must be taken to avoid mixing and mingling of cohorts when entering and exiting the assembly or presentation.

Fully vaccinated visitors (including parents and carers) are only allowed to attend if completing a specific role (such as presenting) and at the invitation of the school. All visitors must check in using the school check-in and show proof of vaccination. I would like to thank all parents and carers for adhering to the public health guidelines.

#### **Kindergarten Orientation Day**

It is with great excitement that we are now able to have our kindergarten orientation onsite, due to the easing in restrictions. Our first onsite orientation day will be on Tuesday 16 November. It will start at 12:00pm and conclude at 1:00pm. During this time, Mr McMahon will be out in the car park talking with parents, if parents want to leave and return at 1:00pm to pick their child up that is also allowed. Under the current restrictions, only one fully vaccinated parent/carers can accompany the child to the orientation day. Evidence of vaccination will need to be sighted at the school gate upon entry.

#### **Remembrance Day**

I would like to thank Mrs James and Miss Stuart for organising the day and assisting the SRC with leading the assembly on Thursday. The assembly was viewed via Zoom to adhere to current COVID restrictions. It is such a significant day in our history, and it was wonderful to see all students and teachers paying their respect. **Lest we Forget.** 

#### P and C

I received a phone call from Ms Pru Car, MP (Member of Londonderry) this week who notified me that our school P and C had been successful in obtaining a \$25,000 grant which will go towards building covered walkways in front of the demountable classrooms. This will be a wonderful asset to the school as it will minimise the students getting wet when it rains and provide additional shade during summer. I would like to thank both Mrs Byrnes and Miss Brownly for doing an amazing job with the application. Without their dedication, this grant would not have been awarded to the school.



#### Uniforms/hats

Just informing parents we have both the yellow everyday shirt and white sport shirt for sale. The school purchased these uniforms to allow all new stock to be placed onto shelves at Back to Basics. We will be selling the shirts from the office for \$25 (which is the cost price). This may be of assistance to families who need a shirt to complete the year and purchase new shirts after the new year. Our school is also selling school hats from the front office for \$18.

Back to Basics currently has all the new everyday greens shirts in stock, however, only has some sizes in the sports shirt. I will continue to update the community as the additional stock arrives at the store.

#### **PBL Rewards Day**

I am carefully looking at the restrictions as I am looking at booking a PBL Rewards Day for the students who have demonstrated safety, been respectful and have also participated in the classroom and out on the playground. I am hoping to book Penrith Ripples like previous years to celebrate the end of the year with students who have displayed positive behaviour.

Congratulations to all students in Year 5 who participated in providing a speech to be chosen as either the school captain or vice-captain for 2022. Our canteen is open on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Thanks to our canteen manager, Erin for organising all rosters to ensure the canteen can operate this term. I would also like to thank the volunteers who have been able to assist this term.

#### New demountable

Our new demountable is nearly fully completed. The furniture has arrived, and the carpet has been laid. We are just waiting for the electrical and plumbing to be completed. Once this has been finalised, our school will be able to utilise this space.
